ENTRY FEE is £5.00 per horse, per class (CHS members) or £6 (non-members). Entries from owners of any registered Caspian or part-bred Caspian are welcome.

Entries will be accepted ONLY by post or email. Please send payment to Entries Secretary, (address above), pay cheques to 'Caspian Horse Society'. NB: CLOSING DATE FOR ALL ENTRIES IS WEDNESDAY 4TH JULY 2018 - please make sure you meet the deadline.

ROSETTES will be awarded to 4th place in all classes, 'Caspians at Ashby' trophies to winners of classes 1-4 and 6.

Performance Cards must be signed by the CHS Show Secretary on the day. Participation in the Parade will add 2 points. Cards can be downloaded from the CHS website www.caspianhorsesociety.org.uk All points are DOUBLED at Ashby.

Caspian Classes will start at approximately 12.00 NOON in Pony Ring 7 in the Horse Field.

Please listen for instructions from show stewards and make sure you arrive at the ringside in good time for your class.

SCHEDULE:

IN -HAND CLASSES for Pure Bred Caspian Horses

Class 1: Licensed Caspian Stallion or Gelding, 4 years old & over

Class 2: Caspian Mare or Brood Mare or Mare with Foal at Foot, 4 yrs & over.

(Special Rosette for Best Foal)

Class 3: Caspian Youngstock 1 to 3 years, colt, filly or gelding

IN-HAND CLASS for Part Bred Caspians

Class 4: Part-Bred Caspian, any sex, any age.

(Special Rosette to Best 3 year old and under)

NEW!!Class 5. Young Handler, age 4-16 years inc., In-hand mares and geldings only (Not eligible for Championship). Special Prize to winner.

RIDDEN CLASS (Mixed Pure and Part-bred)

Class 6: Ridden Pure or Part-bred Caspian, any sex, any age, including lead-rein.

(Special Rosette to Best Rider)

Special Rosette for Best Turned Out will be judged from all classes.

SHOW CHAMPIONSHIP & RESERVE CHAMPIONSHIP - 1st and 2nd placed entrants are eligible from classes 1-4 & 6

NOTES: (See over for Rules for Competition and Directions to Show)

Entries will be accepted by post and email <u>but not by telephone</u>. If by email, payment should follow immediately. Please pay cheques to 'Caspian Horse Society', write 'Show Entries' on reverse and send an SAE if postal acknowledgement is required. Late/on-day entries will attract a £1 additional fee.

Horsebox parking is in the field before the Horse Field. You will receive a pass, tickets and large 'CASPIANS' notice shortly before the show. Please try to park as close to the Horse Field as possible and display the 'CASPIANS' notice in your front or driver's window, to help CHS stewards to spot you. Listen out for Caspian announcements!

Water for horses – a tap is located just to the right of the entrance to the Horse Field from the horsebox park.

CHS reserves the right to amalgamate classes if necessary.

In class 1, geldings and stallions may be judged separately at judge's discretion. In class 4, age and sex of horse will be taken into account. In Class 5 age of rider and suitability to his/her horse will be considered. In Class 6 age of child will be taken into consideration.

Please ensure you bring your current Performance Points cards to the show or collect one with your number.

A PARADE OF CASPIANS AND PART-BREDS will NOT take place this year.

Please note that stabling is not available on the showground but can be arranged locally.

To arrange stabling, please contact Mrs Jane Harding, Ashby Show Secretary, <info@ashbyshow.com> It is in your own interests to arrange stabling as early as possible. You will be expected to liaise directly with your stabling host regarding cost, arrival time etc. Please be sure to leave your stable clean on departure.

Competitor numbers will be obtainable from the Show Secretary at the CHS stand from around 10.00 a.m. on show day. Same number will apply to that horse in all classes.

Food and drink will be available on the showground and light refreshments at the CHS stand for a donation to CHS. **Toilets are easily accessible** from the CHS stand. **Qualified First Aiders** will be on the show ground.

The venue is a busy agricultural show. Please keep dogs on leads at all times and respect the Ashby Show and site information and rules. *See www.ashbyshow.com for information, or email info@ashbyshow.com*

Please take all rubbish (including droppings) away with you and leave your horsebox area tidy when you depart.

RULES of COMPETITION:

- 1) The judge's decision is final.
- 2) The CHS reserves the right to refuse entry or amalgamate classes as necessary.
- 3) The CHS accepts no responsibility for accident, death illness or injury, howsoever caused. Competitors and exhibitors must indemnify the CHS against any liability arising out of any action in which they may be involved.
- 4) Refund of entry fees due to non-attendance will only be made on the production of a doctors' or vets' certificate.
- 5) Any horse or competitor behaving improperly will be asked to leave the showground.
- 6) Entries will only be acknowledged if a stamped self-addressed envelope is enclosed or if the entries are submitted by email. If the latter, payment must follow immediately by post or else notify that it will be paid at the show stand.
- 7) Foals must be at least 28 days old on the day of the show and must be led in halters or foal slips
- 8) A hat up to PASO15 must be worn by riders at all times they are mounted, wherever they are on the showground
- 9) Competitors are reminded that Ashby Show Committee's rules on the dress code for leaders in in-hand or ridden classes should be followed. Jeans are not appropriate.
- 10) Ridden animals must be 4 years old and over at 1st January 2019.
- 11) Neither spurs, nor whips longer than 30" are permitted in any class
- 12) Stallions and colts must be suitably bitted and under control and may not be handled/led by a person under 18 years of age. Stallions may only be ridden if written permission is first obtained from the CHS Chairman. When requesting permission, the owner's/keeper's statement as to the stallion's safe behaviour when ridden in mixed company should be sent to the Chairman (*see below), along with the age of his rider and the show and classes to be entered. All, plus the Chairman's permission, should be included with the entry form when sending to the show secretary. Please allow sufficient time for your request to be considered and paperwork to be returned. In the interests of safety the stallion must wear identifying discs* on both sides of his bridle. - 13) In lead rein classes the lead rein must be attached to the back of the noseband of the bridle.
- 14) Ages of riders to be taken as day of show, ages of horses to be taken from 01/01/2019. Every attempt will be made to adhere to the timetable shown. However, competitors should keep track of their classes and present themselves promptly when their class is called in. The judge has the right to refuse entry if judging has already started.
- 15) It is the responsibility of competitors to make themselves familiar with the rules of Ashby Show Committee and to ensure that they have all documentation required for entry to the showground (see website address Notes, above).

DIRECTIONS TO ASHBY SHOW: Cattows Farm, Normanton Lane, Heather, Leics., LE67 2TD

From M42/A42 - Leave at Junction 12, take B5006 South, shortly turn 1st left onto Measham Road. Go through village of Packington and join Heather Lane, (becomes Normanton Road/Ashby Road/Heather Lane). Cattows Farm is on a restricted access lane, well back from the road on the right, before Heather.

From A447- Enter Ibstock, then join Melbourne Road. Turn west (left) for Heather at double mini roundabout in Ibstock. Join Ashby Road, Pisca Lane, through Heather, continue on Normanton Lane. Cattows Farm is on a restricted access lane, well back from the road on the left.

From M1 – Leave at Junction 22, take A511 towards Coalville. When the dual carriageway ends, filter left onto B585 Beveridge Lane. Head towards lbstock and join Leicester Road. At Co-op roundabout turn right (west) onto Ashby Road. Go straight over double mini roundabout onto Pisca Lane, through Heather, continue on Normanton Lane. Cattows Farm is on a restricted access lane, well back from the road on the left.

FROM ALL DIRECTIONS: Look for signs for the **RED HORSE GATE**, which is to the side of the main showground. The Horsebox Park is just through the gate and the Horse Field is through a wide opening in the hedge ahead of you.

Pony Ring 7 is the first ring on your right and the CHS stand will be seen next to it. Thank you for taking part. We hope you have a lovely day!
