

Breed Standard Approval for Licensed Stallions.

The BSA scheme for licensed stallions is a voluntary scheme which aims to encourage the preservation of the unique Caspian qualities by Caspian breeders.

Owners of licensed stallions are invited to have their stallion appraised by a panel of CHS approved judges to qualify for a BSA certificate in accordance with the Breed Standard.

They are entitled to append the initials B.S.A. to these stallions' names wherever they are shown, with the exception of the International Caspian Stud Book, under the same terms as are attached to their stallion licences.
