THIS NEW POINTS CARD should be used for all equestrian activities in which your horse takes part, whether competitive or con-competitive. Since driving can be more costly in funding, time and effort, points have been weighted accordingly. The new points are intended to encompass a wider variety of equestrian activities and give a more even allocation of rewards for exposing your Caspian or part-bred to the public.

Competitive events may include show classes, show jumping, racing, combined driving, ridden or driven cross-country competitions, gymkhanas or any event in which horses compete against each other for a prize or rosette. Placings must be countersigned by a show or CHS official on the day, please.

Non-competitive events may include club rallies, Pony Club camp, Junior Polo, hunting, TREC, pony-trekking, club or charity rides/drives – in short, any type of equestrian activity not performed in competition with others for a prize of any kind. This must be countersigned by an unrelated adult (over 18 years old).

Highest Placed Caspian? In addition, if shown in a mixed breed class, a special **HPC Rosette** can be claimed after the event, on provision of written proof of your placing and when and where it took place. This must be countersigned by an unrelated adult.

4th: 6 (8)
5th: 4 (6)
6th: 2 (4)
Competed but unplaced: 1 point.
