RULES & REGULATIONS OF MEMBERSHIP

Amended and effective from
April 2016

1. The financial year of the Society shall be from 1st April to 31st March and Annual Membership shall relate to that period.
 - a. Annual Subscriptions are due on or before 1st April and membership shall be deemed to have lapsed if a subscription remains unpaid on 30th April. All fees must be paid in £ sterling.
 - b. New members joining between 1st January and 1st April shall not be required to renew their membership until 1st April in the year following that in which they joined. No refund of subscriptions shall be given upon resignation of membership.
 - c. Membership subscriptions shall be at the rates laid down by Council and will be reviewed annually; the current rates may be obtained from the Membership Secretary or seen on the Society website.
2. Categories of membership.
 - a. Full voting membership of the Society (necessary to obtain benefits of lower registration fees) shall be open to UK and Overseas residents who have paid the appropriate full annual subscriptions or those who have subscribed as Life members, either as individuals or as two Family members. (Family members under 18 are non-voting.)
 - b. Honorary memberships shall be non-voting.
 - c. Non-Voting membership shall also be open to overseas residents.
 - d. Junior membership is non-voting and open to young people under 18 years of age.
3. Memberships are to be ratified by Council.
4. Members are responsible for informing the Membership Secretary of any changes in their contact details.
5. There will be no discrimination between members. Non-members are also eligible to register their stock in the appropriate categories as laid down in these rules, but at higher rate.
6. Any member who fails to observe any lawful rule or regulation of the society or whose conduct in any respect Council considers derogatory to the character or prejudicial to the interest of the society maybe removed from the society.
7. The CHS is a registered charity and as such any individual with serious concerns regarding the conduct of the charity has a right and a duty to make those concerns known to the charities commission.
