

## THE CASPIAN HORSE SOCIETY POINTS FOR PERFORMANCE SCHEME

The Caspian Horse Society runs a "Points For Performance Scheme" for Caspian owners, every year.

All Registered Caspian Horses, both Pure and Part Bred, that are presented at ANY competition or event throughout the Country are eligible to participate in the scheme. This includes ridden/in-hand or driven Caspian Horses in all types of event and is open to both members and non-members of the Caspian Horse Society.

The aim of the Performance Scheme is to bring our beautiful breed to the eyes of the horse-loving public. By entering competitions we give the Caspian a chance to show its capabilities, looking good and usually in knowledgeable company, which is crucial to the survival and growth of the breed. The owner of the horse with the most points will be sent a superb Sash and Rosette at the end of each Showing Season.

To be included in the Scheme, you will need to obtain a CHS 'Points for Performance' card, as early in the show and competition season as possible. This is free of charge and can be downloaded from this website or contact: Helen Thirlby: [helenthirlby@gmail.com](mailto:helenthirlby@gmail.com) There are separate cards for a)Riding/In-Hand and b)Driving and the one you require should be stipulated when requesting a card.

Performance Points are awarded as follows:

Champion 15 pts

Res. Champion 12 pts.

1st place 10 pts

2nd 9 pts

3rd 8 pts

4th 7 pts

5th 6 pts

6th 5 pts

Entered but unplaced – 1 pt

National, County or Qualifying shows will gain you double points. Ashby Show will also gain you double points.

Your Caspian or Part-Bred Caspian may also win a Highest Placed Caspian (HPC) rosette if you notify Helen where and when you will be showing in time for her to post a rosette to the Show Secretary.

If you are awarded an HPC rosette, add another 2 points!

NB - Cards must be signed by the event's Show Secretary to confirm the result you have achieved. They should be returned to Helen Thirlby by the 31st October. Only original or photocopied cards will be accepted – by post, NOT email please.
