



## THE CASPIAN HORSE SOCIETY'S POINTS FOR PERFORMANCE SCHEME

*The Caspian Horse Society runs an annual 'Points for Performance' Scheme for Caspian owners.*

**All registered Caspian Horses, both Pure and Part Bred, that are presented or placed at any type of competition or event, throughout the United Kingdom, are eligible to participate in the scheme. This includes ridden/in-hand or driven Caspian Horses at events large or small, and is open to both members and non-members of the Caspian Horse Society.**

**The aim of the Performance Scheme is, of course, to bring our beautiful breed to the eyes of the horse-loving public. By entering competitions, usually in knowledgeable company, we give the Caspian a chance to show its capabilities, looking good, which is *crucial to the survival and growth of the breed*. The owner of the horse with the most points in each year will be sent a superb Sash and Rosette at the end of each Showing Season and the win will be announced in the society's magazine 'The Caspian' and on the website <[caspianhorsesociety.org.uk](http://caspianhorsesociety.org.uk)>.**

To be included in the Scheme, you will need to start filling in a CHS 'Points for Performance' card as early in the show and competition season as possible. The card is supplied free of charge and there are separate cards for a) Riding or In-Hand events and b) Driving. Further Points cards can be obtained from me, Elizabeth Webster <[lizwebster08@gmail.com](mailto:lizwebster08@gmail.com)> or by post to *Old Sock Cottage, Mudford Sock, Yeovil, Somerset BA22 8EA - and a stamped self-addressed envelope minimum size A5 would be appreciated.*

Performance Points are awarded as shown on the cards. Please note that results from National, County or Qualifying shows will gain you double points. Ashby Show's Caspian classes will also gain you double points.

**For those who only occasionally show, your Caspian or Part-Bred Caspian can win a Highest Placed Caspian (HPC) rosette** if you notify me where and when you will be showing in time for me to post a rosette to the nominated Show Secretary (allow a minimum of 7 days). If you are awarded an HPC rosette, add another 2 points to your card!

NB – Points Cards must be signed by *either* the event's Show Secretary, your Judge or your Class Steward to confirm the result you have achieved. This rule will be adhered to, so please don't forget! Cards should be returned to me **by the 31st October of the same year**. Only original or photocopied cards will be accepted, by post. *(Sorry, but for the sake of clarity, scans sent by email will NOT be accepted in future).*
